

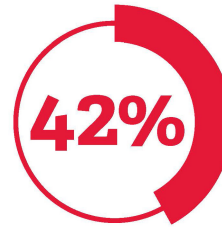

Miami University offers two merit-based scholarships for new first-year international students:

	International Education Scholarship	University Merit Scholarship
Annual Award Amount	\$2,000 - \$16,000; renewable up to four years	\$1,000 to full tuition; renewable up to four years
Award Determination	Amount determined by academic records, test scores, and other factors received by Miami University at the time of application	Amount determined by academic records, test scores, and other factors received by Miami University at the time of application
GPA	No minimum; GPA will determine award amount	3.50/4.00 U.S. GPA or equivalent (minimum)
Test Score Requirement	No minimum; test scores (IELTS, TOEFL, ACT, or SAT) will determine award amount	ACT of 27 or higher OR SAT (ERW+M) of 1260 or higher

All new first-year undergraduate international students who submit completed applications and meet the requirements for full admission for Fall 2019 are automatically considered for the International Education Scholarship and University Merit Scholarship. Miami University scholarships are highly competitive and, thus, not guaranteed. The academic qualifications determining scholarship awards are dependent on the strength of the applicant pool. No separate application is required.

- Priority consideration will be given to first-year students completing all admission requirements by **December 1, 2018**.
- International transfer students will also be considered for transfer scholarship opportunities at the time of admission.
