Location: Oxford, Ohio (56 kilometers north of Cincinnati, Ohio), rated best college town by *Forbes* in 2016.

Established: 1809. Miami University's name reflects the history of the Native American tribe that once inhabited the Miami Valley region of Ohio.

Total Enrollment: 19,286 (16,900 undergraduate students and 2,386 graduate students)
