Miami's early applications up

A record number of students are taking advantage of Miami University's early application deadlines this recruitment season.

Miami's continued growth in applications was created through a strong increase in interest from students throughout the state, the nation and the world, according to university officials.

Ohio applications are up 10 percent, and out-of-state and international applications are up 22 percent and 86 percent, respectively – an overall increase of 16 percent when compared to this time last year. The university is also seeing an increase in the academic quality of students choosing to apply to Miami.

Miami again offered two early application options this year: Early Decision (binding) and Early Action (non binding). Students who applied by the Dec. 1 Early Action deadline took advantage of priority consideration for the university's best academic programs and merit scholarship awards.

The final deadline for first-year students to apply to Miami for the Fall 2014 semester is Feb. 1.
