☐ Early Action

**Early Action** is **non-binding**. If you are accepted, you are not required to enroll for Fall 2013. Application deadline is Dec. 1; decision notification is Feb. 1.

☐ Regular Decision

**Regular Decision** is **non-binding**. If you are accepted, you are not required to enroll for Fall 2013. Application deadline is Feb. 1; decision notification is March 15. **If you want to know your decision earlier, apply as Early Action (also non-binding).**
