

Forever Buckeye Ohio Residency Application

The Forever Buckeye provision extends in-state tuition rates to graduates from Ohio high schools who meet each of the following criteria: (1) have current legal status to remain permanently in the United States, (2) left Ohio but returned or will return to enroll in an Ohio public institution of higher education, (3) establish a primary residence in Ohio by the first day of classes of the requested term, (4) at the time of graduation from an Ohio high school would have qualified for in-state residency for tuition purposes.

This application and all supporting documents should be submitted at least three weeks prior to the start of the term for which you are enrolling, but no later than the Friday preceding the first day of classes for that term. Additional documentation may be required prior to making a determination regarding your Forever Buckeye Ohio residency eligibility.

The following documents must be submitted with this form:
A copy of your official Ohio high school transcript or a verification of your graduation on the high school's letterhead stationery. A high school diploma is not sufficient evidence of high school graduation.
A copy of your current rental/lease agreement or property deed.
