To	qualify, eligible Oxford undergraduate students must:
1.	Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which computes student's financial need. (Financial need is a student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC) less the Cost of Attendance (COA). Cost of attendance for students studying abroad will include any expenses related to the specific program.)
2. 3.	Attend full-time during either the fall or spring semester in a study abroad program.
4. 5.	program*. Agreement requires your advisor's signature pre-approving course work.
	Luxembourg, Sponsored, and Exchange programs are exempt from the Consortium/Contractual Agreement.
•	If eligible, students will receive an airfare grant up to \$600. In addition, students may request a university loan up to a maximum of \$600 to help finance the remainder of their ticket. This grant is available to a student for one study abroad semester while attending Miami.
•	Students are eligible to request the Study Abroad Airfare Grant no sooner than 180 days before their estimated departure date.
•	The Office of Student Financial Assistance will notify you if you are eligible via your Miami email account. If approved you will be asked to complete an Airfare Grant Promissory Note.

This grant must be accompanied by a 180 Promissory Note (available at our office) if you wish to receive the funds upfront to purchase your ticket. The approximate processing time for receiving the money is 7-10 business days. The Office of the Bursar will charge an "Advance of Airfare Grant & Loan" on your Bursar Bill. This charge will be paid by the airfare funds detailed above 10 days prior the start of your study abroad semester, as long as steps 1-5 above have been completed.
