

Miami University Graduation Survey 2017-2018 Certificate and Associate's Degree Recipients

- The Graduation Survey asked degree candidates about their experiences while attending Miami and their post-graduation plans. The results are split into two categories: 1) all participants who received a certificate or associate's degree, and 2) participants who received only a certificate or associate's degree, and did not receive a higher-level degree. The current report focuses on students who received only a certificate or associate's degree (N = 81, 42.6% response rate).
- Students completed the Graduation Survey online, during their final semester at Miami. Detailed results, including historical comparisons, are attached. Additional results for bachelor's and graduate degree recipients are available online at:

Future Plans

- *Because students complete the Graduation Survey prior to graduation, all information about their future plans is considered preliminary. Complete information on graduates' career and educational placement is available through the New Alumni Success Project (see www.miamioh.edu/oir/surveys/post-graduation).*
- Slightly more students this year plan to continue their education after graduation. 59.3% of 17-18 graduates plan to continue their education during the fall, compared with 58.6% of 16-17 graduates.
- 63.0% of 17-18 graduates plan to work after graduation:
 - 40.7% of graduates planned to work full-time in their field of study while 14.8% planned to work full-time outside their field of study.
 - Among students who had begun searching for employment, 79.4% had received at least one offer of employment or were already working by the time they completed the survey, including 2.9% who planned to be self-employed or start their own business after graduation.
 - Among students who had accepted an offer of employment or were working at the company where they would be employed after graduation, 90.9% had been previously employed with the company. Most (68.2%) were previously employed as a full-time employee.
- Nearly all of the students (88.2%) plan to live in Ohio after graduation.

Experiences at Miami

- 88.9% of students were satisfied or very satisfied with the freedom to express their own ideas, opinions, concerns, and points of view.
- 60.5% of students reported that they had discussions with people of a different background often or very often during the past school year (up from 57.6% last year).
- 33.3% of students reported working on an independent study project during their time at Miami. Only 14.1% of current graduates reported working with a faculty member on a research project, while 14.8% did so in 16-17.
- The percentage of students who reported completing a student teaching experience decreased this year (14.1%) in comparison to last year (17.3%). The percentage completing a practicum decreased

from 1.3% to 0%. In addition, 16.7% of 17-18 graduates completed an internship/co-op while 23.1% completed a field experience, both of which are slight increases.

- Many of the participants reported working while attending classes: 17.3% of students worked part-time on campus, 33.3% worked part-time off-campus, and 50.6% worked full-time while attending classes.
