Scholarships and Aid

- 90%: fall 2024 first-year students who received gift aid
- Average scholarship: Ohio \$6,865; Non-Ohio \$16,729

- \$200,000+ estimated lifetime value of graduating from Miami on-time and starting a career one year earlier than peers.

Notable

- 61% of first-time applicants were accepted into medical school (about 20% higher than the national average)
- 94% law school admission rate, compared to 80% nationally
- Quantum Computing is one of Miami’s newest majors, developed through a partnership with Cleveland Clinic
- Since 2015, more than 200 students and alumni have been awarded national fellowships
- 50+ national social and professional Greek organizations
- 30% student participation in Greek life
