Student will have earned the Lorain County Community College Associate of Arts degree (#8720) and the One-Year General Certificate in English Literature (#4103) at the conclusion of the above curriculum pathway.

Notes:

- Student must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours to earn a LCCC associate degree.
- Once at Miami University, transfer students will still need to complete: Intercultural Perspectives (3 credits), Experiential Learning (0 credits), and Capstone (3 credits). These credits can be earned through completion of the major in English Studies.
- The next semesters will be completed at LCCC and student should work with the UP Miami advisor and/or LCCC advisor prior to registration to fulfill a Miami minor and/or additional LCCC One-Year General Certificate of choice to meet the student's career goals. Student is encouraged to utilize [transferology](#) to see additional transfer equivalent course options from LCCC to Miami.

Students can expect that ENGT courses will be counted as described here.
