Notes:

- Student completing the above curriculum pathway, which fulfills the OT36 and completes an Associate of Arts degree, is thus not required to complete the Miami Global Plan, with the exception of 3 credit hours of Global Inquiry or Intercultural Perspectives (if not completed at LCCC already), and the Knowledge in Action requirements which include Experiential Learning (0 credits) and Capstone (3 credits) requirements, which are included and mapped out in the remaining semesters of this curriculum pathway.
- If student transfers to Miami prior to completion of the OT36/Associate of Arts degree, additional coursework for the Miami Global Plan will be required. Student must consult with Miami advising to discuss transfer implications if deviating from this pathway.
