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Description

Miami University and Sinclair Community College are parties to an agreement titled **INSTITUTIONAL ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI UNIVERSITY AND SINCLAIR COMMUNITY COLLEGE** entered into on January 1, 2024 (the "<u>Agreement</u>"). This Pathway is entered into pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement and is hereby incorporated into the Agreement by this reference. Except as otherwise set forth, the Agreement is unaffected and shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.

The Associate of Arts in English at Sinclair Community College partners well with the Bachelor of Arts in English Studies degree at Miami University.

The Bachelor of Arts in English Studies requires 42 credit hours. At least 18 of those hours must be earned at Miami, including the 12 of the final 30 credit hours. The matches below indicate specific courses you may be awarded after successfully completing those courses and transferring to Miami University. Students must complete a minimum of 30 total credits at Miami University including 12 of the final 30 credit hours required for the baccalaureate degree.

To graduate with the Bachelor of Arts in Computer Science degree students must first meet all Miami University admission requirements noted on this <u>website</u>. Students must also meet Miami's <u>general requirements for graduation</u>, including: (1) completion of 124 credit hours; (2) completion of a minimum of 30 credit hours at Miami of which the final 12 credit hours must be taken at Miami; and (3) attainment of a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average at the time of graduation.

Students completing the OT36 through their General Education credits will have completed most requirements for Miami Plan Perspectives Areas and Signature Inquiries. Students entering Miami having completed the OT36 must complete 9 credits of Signature Inquiry, however this may be met by matching equivalent Perspectives courses that have a Signature Inquiry designation. Students will need to complete coursework in Global Citizenship (Intercultural Consciousness or Global Inquiry for 3 credits), Knowledge in Action: Experiential Learning (0 credits), and a Senior Capstone (3 credits).

The plan of study below illustrates: (1) how a student can complete an Associate of Arts degree at Sinclair Community College and how those courses transfer to Miami University, and (2) what courses the student needs to complete at Miami to earn the Bachelor of Arts in Computer Science degree. Please note the matches in this document indicate specific courses you may be awarded after successfully completing those courses and transferring to Miami University.

Courses that do not have a Miami University equivalent will be recorded as "T" courses on the student's Miami University academic record. With the assistance of an academic advisor, students can petition for some "T" courses to count toward Miami University degree requirements.

These courses do not have Miami University equivalents; they will be recorded as "T" courses on the student's transcript. With the assistance of their academic advisor, the student requests (through petition) for the ENGT courses to count toward English Studies requirements as described below. Students can expect that ENGT courses will be counted as described here.

The following is an overview of the requirements in the 42 credit English Studies major at Miami University:

BA in English Studies Requirements: CORE:

ENG 298 Intro to Literary and Cultural Studies (3 cr) EGS 301 Writing and the Professions (3 cr) ENG 495 Capstone (3 cr)

DISTRIBUTION:

Readings in Literary History: Survey and Genre (9 cr) Studies in Writing (at least one at 300/400 level) (9 cr) Multicultural and Linguistic Perspectives (9 cr) Additional 300/400 level EGS not used above (6 cr)

Table 2 shows how students completing their coursework at Sinclair Community College will have completed up to 24 of 42 required credit hours in the major:

Students completing the Associate of Arts with an English pathway earn 62 credit hours that transfer to Miami University.

Students completing the OT36 through their General Education credits will have completed most requirements for Miami Plan Perspectives Areas and Signature Inquiries. At Miami University, transfer students will still need to complete coursework in Global Citizenship (Intercultural Consciousness or Global Inquiry for 3 credits), Knowledge in Action: Experiential Learning (o credits), and Capstone (3 credits).

These credits can be earned through completion of the major in English Studies. They will need to complete a total of 62 hours to reach the 124 required for the BA depending on what they have earned at Sinclair Community College.

Table 3 shows how a student completes the English Studies major having completed 24 of the required 42 credit hours through their coursework at Sinclair Community College. The table is merely a guide; student choices while at Sinclair Community College may require changes to how the student completes the degree at Miami University. In addition to the courses listed here, students will be expected to complete the required hours for graduation with a baccalaureate degree. Students are expected to meet with an advisor to discuss course selection and planning.
