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7	X.1. When bargaining unit members retire and meet necessary conditions, they are eligible for
8	the status of Emeritus or Emerita. The following sections describe the eligibility
9	requirements and future privileges of current unit members.
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	<u>1.X.2.</u> Professor Emeritus / Emerita
12	X.1.1.X.2.1. To be eligible for appointment to the rank of Professor Emeritus / Emerita of
13	Miami University, a personcurrent bargaining unit member must:
14	X.1.1.1.X.2.1.1. have been granted tenure or continuing contract;
15	X.1.1.2.X.2.1.2. have been a full time member of the faculty for at least ten (10) years; and
16	X.1.1.1. have retired from Miami University; and,
17	X.1.1.3.X.2.1.3. be recommended by the President to and approved by the Board of
18	Trustees. Such appointment shall not be unreasonably denied.
19	X.1.2.X.2.2. Regardless of rank at before retirement, the designation will be as appropriate:

21	X.1.2.2.X.2.2.2. Teaching Professor Emeritus/a

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27.	2. <u>X.3.</u> Privileges of Emeritus / Emerita faculty.
28	X.2.1.X.3.1. Library privileges
29	X.2.1.1.X.3.1.1. Emeritus / Emerita faculty shall upon request have the same library usage
30	privileges as continuing faculty. These privileges include, but are not
31	limited to:
32	X.2.1.1.1.X.3.1.1.1. access to OhioLink and other interlibrary loan services; and
33	X.2.1.1.2.X.3.1.1.2. access to all online databases, indexes, and other electronic
34	resources from home as allowed by the license(s).
35	X.2.1.2.X.3.1.2. This request may be made at any time and such privileges shall only be
36	revoked upon request from the Emeritus / Emerita faculty member.

The Union reserves the right to add to, delete from, alter or amend this proposal. This proposal is made without precedent or prejudice to existing rights and entitlements, regardless of the character or source of same. Any tentative agreements reached between the parties on any proposals shall not become final until (1) the parties have reached final agreement on a full collective bargaining agreement, and (2) the Union membership has ratified the full collective bargaining agreement.

38		department(s) or program(s), Emeritus/Emerita faculty shall be provided access to
39		an office or desk space with facilities generally similar to other department
40		faculty, including but not limited to access to a computer and to Miami data and
41		communication services. Such requests shall not be unreasonably denied.
42	X.2.3. X.3.3.	_For the first five years after retirement, Emeritus/Emerita faculty shall have access
43		to download or purchase Miami-provided software or computer programs on the
44		same terms as continuing faculty.
45	X.2.4. X.3.4.	Emeritus / Emerita faculty shall retain in perpetuity email addresses and virtual
46		storage privileges similar to continuing faculty.

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
