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7	X.1. When bargaining unit members retire and meet necessary conditions, they are eligible for		
8	the status of Emeritus or Emerita. The following sections describe the eligibility

12	X.2.1. To be eligible for appointment to the rank of Professor Emeritus / Emerita of		
13	Miami University, a current bargaining unit member must:		
14	X.2.1.1. have been granted tenure or continuing contractpromotion;		
15	X.2.1.2. have been a full time member of the faculty for at least ten (10) years; and		
16	X.2.1.3. be recommended by the President to and approved by the Board of		
17	Trustees. Such appointment shall not be unreasonably denied.

26	X.3. Privileges of Emeritus / Emerita faculty.		
27	X.3.1. Library privileges		
28	X.3.1.1. For at least the first five years after retirement, Emeritus / Emerita faculty		
29	shall upon request have the same library usage privileges as continuing		
30	faculty. These privileges include, but are not limited to:		
31	X.3.1.2. access to OhioLink and other interlibrary loan services; and		
32	X.3.1.3. access to all online databases, indexes, and other electronic resources from		
33	home as allowed by the license(s).		
34	X.3.1.4.X.3.1.1. This request may be made at any time and such privileges shall only be		
35	revoked upon request from the Emeritus / Emerita faculty member.		
36	X.3.2. For at least the first five years after retirement and upon written request from their		
37	department(s) or program(s), Emeritus/Emerita faculty shall, as practicable within		

	university resources, be provided access to an office or desk space with facilities
	generally similar to other department faculty, including but not limited to access
	to a computer and to Miami data and communication services. Such requests shall
	not be unreasonably denied.
X.3.3.	For at least the first five years after retirement, Emeritus/Emerita faculty shall
	have access to download or purchase Miami-provided software or computer
	programs on the same terms as continuing faculty.
X.3.4.	Emeritus / Emerita faculty shall retain in perpetuity email addresses and virtual
	storage privileges similar to continuing faculty.
