After reviewing the 5-year Interim Progress Report (IPR) submitted by Miami University, the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) has rejected the IPR as not having demonstrated sufficient progress toward addressing deficiencies identified in the most recent visiting team report. Specifically, the program did not provide sufficient evidence for the following: II.2.2 Professional Degrees and Curriculum, A.4 Technical Documentation, A.9 Historical Traditions and Global Culture, and B.2 Accessibility. In addition, these SPC were Not Met for two consecutive visits.

Consistent with the <u>2015 *Procedures*</u>, Section 10.1.d.ii Interim Progress Reports, pages 81-82, the next accreditation visit is advanced by one calendar year and is now scheduled for spring 2023. The Architecture Program Report (APR) is due September 7, 2022.

Please note that Statistical Reports are still due annually.
