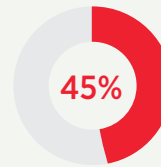

COMPENSATION

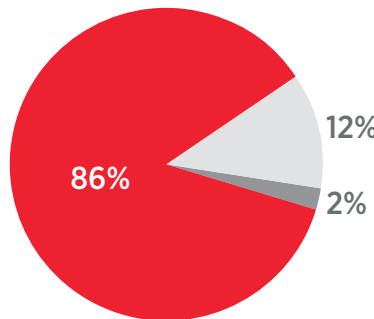
For students who reported salary information, the average total compensation, including signing bonus, was **\$72,604**
