And you'll be immersed in our **one-of-a-kind First Year Integrated Core**—a series of four business courses that set the stage for your success, teaching you invaluable business and life skills, including Critical Thinking, Ethical Thinking / Cultural Intelligence, Communication, Creative Thinking and Computational Thinking, and Coding. Farmer School first year **students move through these classes in teams**, **working together** from the beginning of the semester to the end, culminating with a final client project. The integrated core allows students to individually build critical skills and collaboratively work for a real client, all while analyzing real data. Students learn skills, apply knowledge, and present their creative, computational, and analytic findings to senior executives.
