THE PROGRAM

The Combined Bachelor's/Master's program at Miami allows high achieving students to graduate in four years with both a BA or BS degree in economics and the MA degree. Students may enter the MA program at the beginning of their senior year. The MA degree provides students with intensive, technical training in economics in preparation for careers or future study that demands advanced research and empirical techniques.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for the program, Miami economics majors must:

- be full-time students;
- have completed ECO 311, ECO 315 and ECO 317 with a combined GPA in these classes of at least 3.5 and
 have completed MTH 151.

The combined degree requires careful planning. Please contact an advisor as soon as possible if you are considering the program.
