COMPENSATION

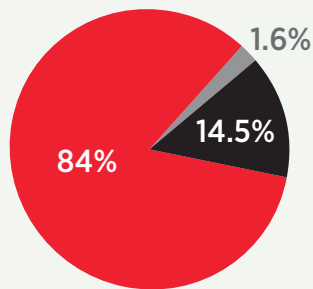
For students who reported salary information, the average total compensation, including bonus, was **\$73,048**
