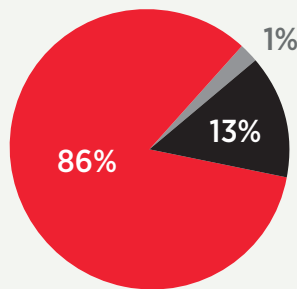
COMPENSATION

For students who reported salary information, the average total compensation, including bonus, was **\$78,879**

At graduation, only **13%** of respondents were seeking employment.



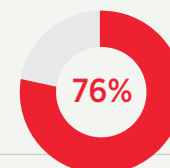
