Statement of Parental Consent To Proposed Summer Employment

SECTION I.

In accordance with H.B. 1002, passed April 26, 1980 by the 113th General Assembly of the Ohio State Senate, minors aged sixteen or seventeen may file conclusive proof of age (birth certificate) and a statement of parental consent to their summer employment with their employer in lieu of an age and schooling certificate (work permit), as a condition of their employment <u>only during summer vacation months</u>. Summer vacation is defined as starting the last day of the spring term and ending before the first day of the fall term at the secondary school which the minor attends.

For this form to be used in lieu of an age and schooling certificate (work permit), Section II, statement of proposed conditions of summer employment, and Section III, statement of consent, must be signed by the minor and his/her parent or guardian in the presence of a notary public. For the purpose of Section III, if there is no parent or guardian, a person over eighteen years of age with whom the minor normally or regularly resides may sign the consent statement.
