Reminder: New Hire Employment Onboarding is Required for All New Employees

As a reminder, OHRM hosts **employment onboarding meetings** for all new hires to ensure that all employee paperwork and tasks, including the employee's I-9, are completed to comply with federal and state regulations. These meetings are **mandatory** for all new employees including visiting instructors, Graduate Assistants, student employees, staff, and faculty. Departments should communicate with their new hires prior to their start date that on their first day of work, their attendance at the employment onboarding meeting is **mandatory** and new hires should not begin any other work prior to attending this meeting.
