What We Are Doing This Month

Moon Shot Program Owners are finalizing initial best practices based on findings from our Equity Best Practice Diagnostic. Each institution will select three common best practices that will begin implementation in the spring. Institutions may choose to include the implementation of additional best practices as appropriate.

Team leaders will participate in a half day leadership institute in February to ensure they are fully equipped to manage and implement the best practice. Team leaders will have input in implementation strategies and developing outcomes.

February Leadership Institute for Team Leaders

Team Leaders who are selected will participate in a 3-hour leadership institute on February 15th, official invitations will go out in late January. The Institute will prepare leaders for executing each practice by providing training on the following:

- **Project Management:** Leaders will receive project management training and review our project management tool- Asana. Team leaders will review a pre-built plan for their respective practice.
- **Research & Strategies for Each Best Practice:** Leaders will receive training on the appropriate approach to implement the best practice. Leaders will be provided with resources on the practices based on learnings from dozens of student success studies held with our 1500 partners.
- **Inclusive Leadership Self Assessment:** Leaders will complete a self assessment to assist with private reflection and learning on one's knowledge and awareness to lead each team inclusively and assist with building an inclusive culture on campus.

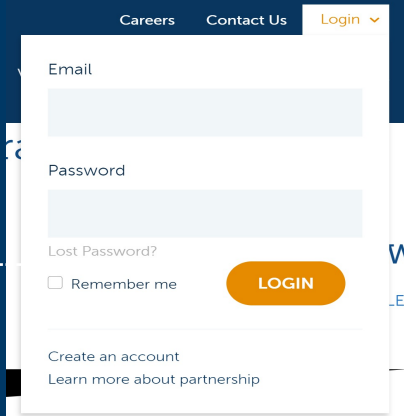
