DO...

Use images and diagrams to support text



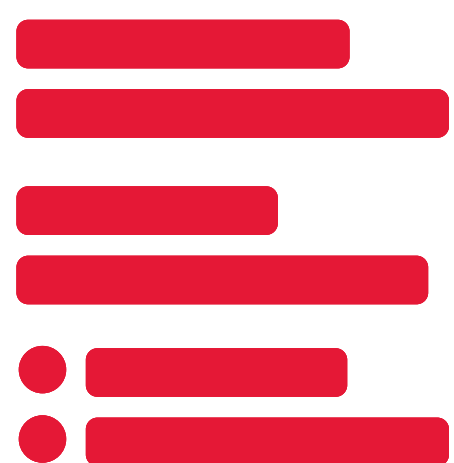
Align text to the left & keep a consistent layout



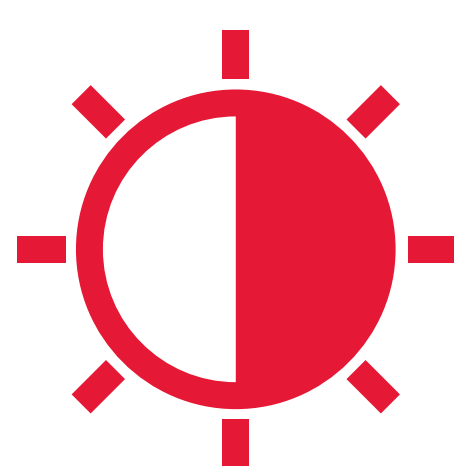
Consider producing materials in other formats, like audio or video



Keep content short, clear & simple



Let users change contrast between background & text



DON'T...

Use large blocks of heavy text



Underline words, use italics, or all capitals

DON'T DO THIS

Force users to remember things from previous pages - give reminders & prompts



Rely on accurate spelling - use autocorrect or provide suggestions



Put too much information in one place
