Executive Summary

- The Office of Institutional Research collected educational and career placement data for 2015-16 College of Liberal Arts and Applied Science (CLAAS) bachelor's degree recipients from numerous sources, including the New Alumni Online Survey, the New Alumni Phone Survey, graduation surveys (including surveys administered by Institutional Research, the Farmer School of Business, and the College of Engineering and Computing), the National Student Clearinghouse, public LinkedIn profiles, and Miami University's Banner data system. Results are based on alumni placement as of fall 2016.
- Educational placement data were available for 100% of alumni while career placement data were available for 65% of alumni (excluding those who were enrolled in graduate/professional school). Information on alumni's current state/country of residence was also obtained for 76% of alumni.

Combined Educational and Career Placement

- Combined, 94.8% of 2015-16 alumni were either employed or enrolled as of fall 2016.
 - This is a decrease from last year, when 97.5% of alumni were employed or enrolled. For previous years' reports, visit www.miamioh.edu/oir/Surveys/Post-Graduation.
- Placement rates by department ranged from 91.5% (Interdisciplinary and Communication Studies) to 100% (Nursing).

Educational Placement

- 7.0% of alumni were enrolled in school, including 3.5% who were enrolled at the master's level, 0.3% who were enrolled in a doctoral level program, and 1.3% who were pursuing additional undergraduate study.
 - This is a slight decrease from last year, when 8.8% of alumni enrolled in school after graduating from Miami.
- Engineering Technology alumni (11.3% enrolled) and Justice and Community Studies alumni (10.5% enrolled) were most likely to enroll in school after graduating from Miami, while Nursing alumni were least likely to enroll in school after graduating from Miami (3.5% enrolled).

Career Placement

- Among alumni who were not enrolled in graduate or professional school, 93.4% were currently employed, including 2.0% who were self-employed or running their own business.
 - The employment rate decreased from last year, when 97.2% of CLAAS alumni were employed.
- Although overall employment placement rates are lower for CLAAS alumni this year, there are signs of improvement in the type of jobs that they are obtaining.

- For example, 60.6% of 2015-16 alumni were employed in a full-time position in their field, compared to 57.5% of 2014-15 alumni.
- In addition, over the past three years, there has been a continuous increase in the percentage of alumni whose positions require a college degree.
 - Among the 2015-16 graduating class, 82.0% of employed alumni were working in a position that required a college degree.
 - In comparison, 73.6% of 2013-14 alumni and 78.2% of 2014-15 alumni were employed in positions that required a college degree.
- 54.4% of employed alumni had worked for their current employer previously, most commonly as a full-time employee (27.5%) or as a part-time or seasonal employee (13.8%).
 - This is a large decrease from last year, when 74.6% of employed alumni had worked for their employer previously, with 51.8% working previously as a full-time employee.

State/Country of Residence

- 90.5% of alumni were living in Ohio while 8.7% were living in a different U.S. state.
 - The most recent graduating class was less likely than the 2014-15 graduating class to reside in Ohio after graduation. Among 2014-15 graduates, 96.1% remained in Ohio after graduation.
- Less than 1.0% of alumni were living outside the United States.

¹ Due to the small size of many of the departmental graduating classes, large percentage differences may represent a very small number of students (e.g., 2-5 students).

² The "knowledge rate" indicates the percentage of the graduating class for whom we have data, regardless of the source of the data.

³ All items in the "Career Placement" section exclude from analyses individuals who are enrolled in graduate or professional school. This methodology is consistent with the methodology used in the Miami 2020 Plan dashboard indicators.

⁴ Because participants were allowed to select more than one option, responses may total more than 100%.

⁵ In-field/out-of-field status is based on alumni working full-time, those working part-time, and those for whom their FT/PT status is unknown.

⁶ Items marked NA are not available because the response size was too small to allow for analyses ($n < 10$).
