




Miami Regionals offers an extensive array of services, programs, and experiences that help you develop the skills to be a confident learner, engaged citizen, and active leader in your community and in the world.


KIM MARCUM

WHAT IS AN EFC?

An expected family contribution (EFC) is based primarily on your family's income, from two years prior combined with assets, family size and number of family members enrolled in college. The lower your EFC, the higher your aid package could be.

The Miami University Office of Student Financial Assistance and our Miami Regionals Financial Aid Office will contact you through your Miami student email, through the mail, or by phone if you need to submit additional documents to finalize your financial aid.
