

RELY ON PREDICTABLE COSTS

While college costs rise nationally, Miami's Tuition Promise ensures that most costs (including tuition, housing, meals, special purpose fees, and course fees) for new undergraduate students will be frozen for up to four years. This means scholarships and financial aid retain their full value during your education.

FILE THE FAFSA

For need-based scholarships, grants, and other aid, file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as you're able. The FAFSA for the following academic year is available beginning Oct. 1.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ☐ High school diploma (or equivalent).
- ☐ 2.0 GPA in college-level coursework.
- ☐ In good standing at your current/previous institution.
- ☐ Applicants with the strongest academic records are more competitive for selective programs.
- ☐ Some majors in the College of Creative Arts have portfolio, audition, or concept document requirements for admission, and the Farmer School of Business has additional, minimum requirements for transfer admission.

2023 MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

Apply by June 1 for fall or Dec. 1 for spring to receive automatic, priority consideration for merit scholarships. Students who are in their first college semester when they apply will be considered if they earned a cumulative 3.5+ GPA in high school.
