## Miami University Department of Nursing FERPA and Social Security Information Release

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records, both financial and academic. For the student's protection, FERPA limits release of student record information without the student's explicit written consent; however, it also gives the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) the right to review their records if the parent(s)/guardian(s) claim the student as a dependent on their Federal Income Tax Return.

I acknowledge by my signature that I understand although I am not required to release my records, I am giving my consent to release the information. I understand that this release remains in effect unless I revoke such consent in writing and the revocation is delivered to the institution.
